SCHOLARSHIPS

Academic Gift for Juniors

\$500

- Applicants for this gift shall have been Junior Members of the ALA, Dept. of IN for the past 5 years and must now hold a membership card for the current year.
- Applicants must be in their Senior year of an accredited high school.
- This is a one-year academic gift to attend an accredited institution of higher education. Applicants must be of good character and have grades which meet entrance requirements at the institution of their choice. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA using a 4.0 base.

Firkins Veterans' Children Academic Gift

\$1000

- Applicants should be a high school senior who is a current member of the ALA Dept. of IN, SAL Detachment of IN, or a dependent of an Indiana American Legion member.
- Applicant must be a full-time student going to a Junior College, Trade School or Community College
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- This gift shall be given in two installments contingent on a satisfactory completion of the first semester.



Past Presidents Academic Gift

\$500

- Applicant should be a daughter, granddaughter, or great-granddaughter of an ALA member who needs financial assistance in order to attend an accredited school for any medical training.
- Applicant should have maintained a high average in scholarship and must show an interest in and adaptability for profession in the medical field.
- Applicant must be a member of the ALA, if she is eligible for membership.



Hoosier Academic Gift

\$500

- Applicant must be the child, grandchild, or great-grandchild of a veteran of WW I, WWII, Korean, Vietnam Hostilities, Beirut, Grenada, Panama or Persian Gulf who is financially unable to attend college or a school for special training after graduation from high school.
- Applicant should not be under 16 nor over 22 years of age and must be in their senior year or be a graduate of an accredited high school but cannot have attended an institution of higher learning.
